Rising German Tennis Star, Dominik Schulz, Signs a Multi-Year Representation Agreement with Lagardère Unlimited

Schulz won the **German Championships** in singles and doubles **seven times** during his junior tennis career, and has also been a dominant force on the European front reaching the finals of the Boy's 16 & Under European Championships in 2008 and claiming the boy's 16 & under **number one ranking** in August 2008 on the **Tennis Europe Rankings**.

In addition to this, Schulz has been very successful in international competition reaching the **semi-finals** of the **Junior French Open**, the **quarterfinals** of the **Wimbledon Junior Championships** and the **semi-finals** of the prestigious **Eddie Herr Championships** Boy's 14 & Under. At just 17-years-old, Schulz will continue to compete in international junior tournaments, but will also begin what is anticipated to be a very exciting and successful professional tennis career.

“I have worked ten years in Germany from 1990 to 2000, representing some of the very best German tennis players, including 1991 Wimbledon Champion, 1993 Masters Winner, and 1996 French Open finalist, Michael Stich. It’s been a long time since such a young promising talent has emerged from this historically very strong country,” said Lagardère Unlimited President, **Ken Meyerson**. “At Lagardère Unlimited, we are delighted to be working with Dominik and his family.”
